Preliminary Fold... (enlarged) front and back... base complete.



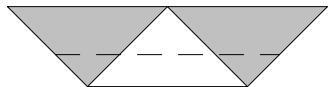
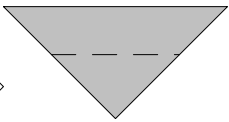
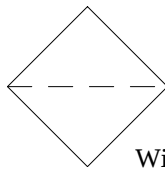
Tail...fold right to left...kite, fold left to right...repeat on left...fold sides front and back.



Leg... inside reverse folds. body points -->

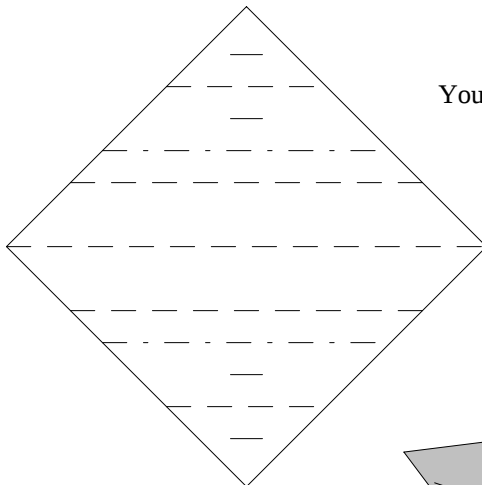
Body... fold in sides (both layers)...repeat at bottom, tail will fit in here.

Fold legs out, then in at mark so they stick up.



Wing... keep folding in _half_ as shown.

... unfold this.

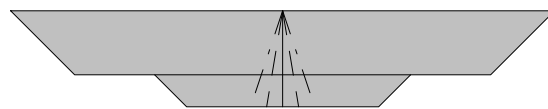


You should see 11 folds.

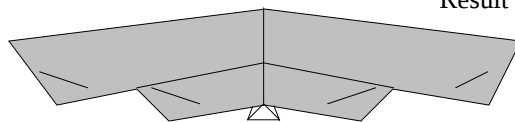
use only the 7 shown,

other 4 marked as guides.

Pleat a triangle, centre shown as guide.



Result is like this.



fold corners to make white wingtips.(repeat below)

triangle under wings goes inside body, then tail acts as peg to hold it all together. Make a beak on the head.
