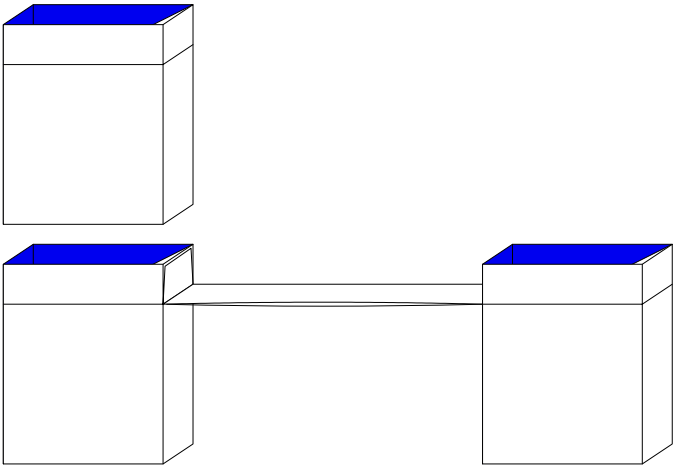
Building the Wall

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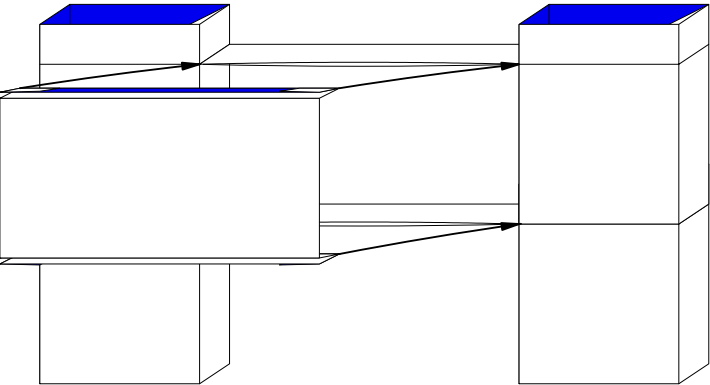
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1 Coupling vertical (A) and horizontal (S) units
