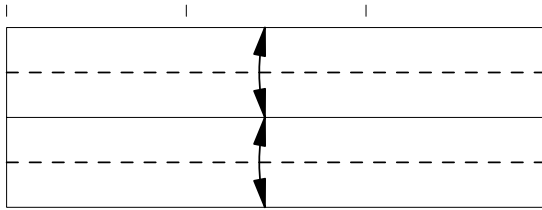


Garland unit 1

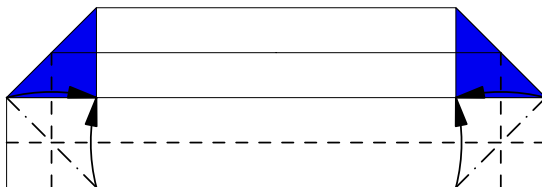

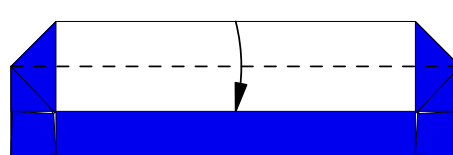

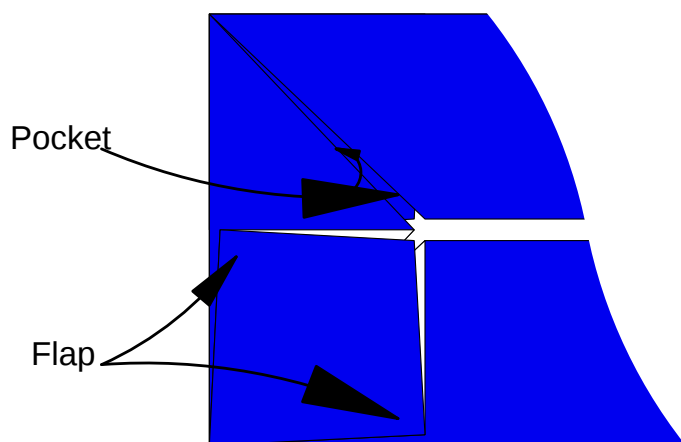

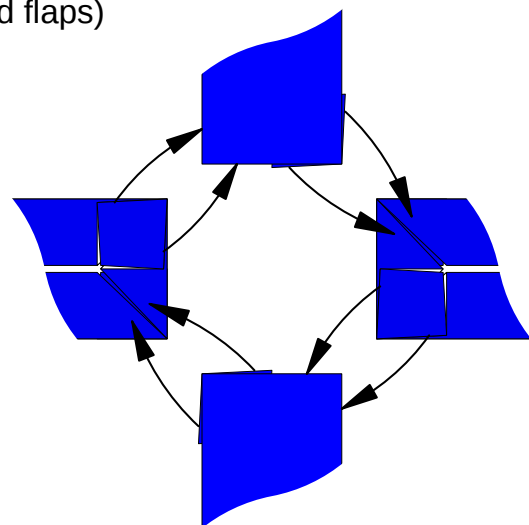
7 Normal unit



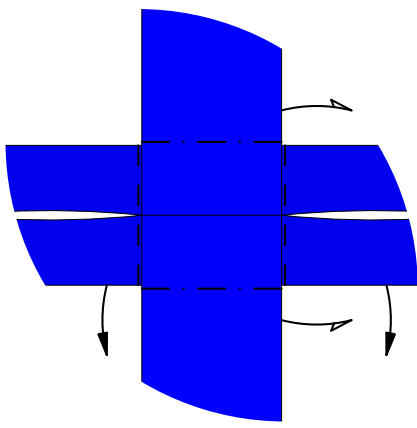
8 Stop unit (mind flaps)



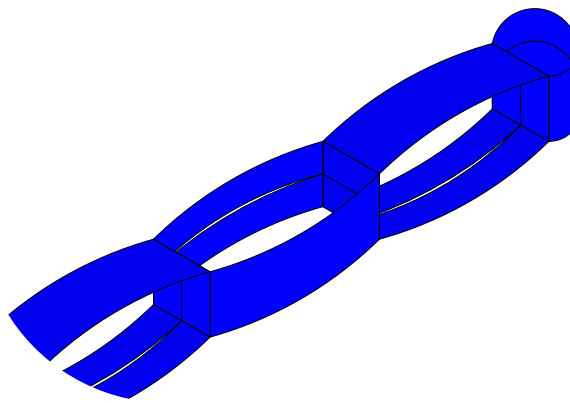
9 Put flaps in pockets of other unit to couple two units.



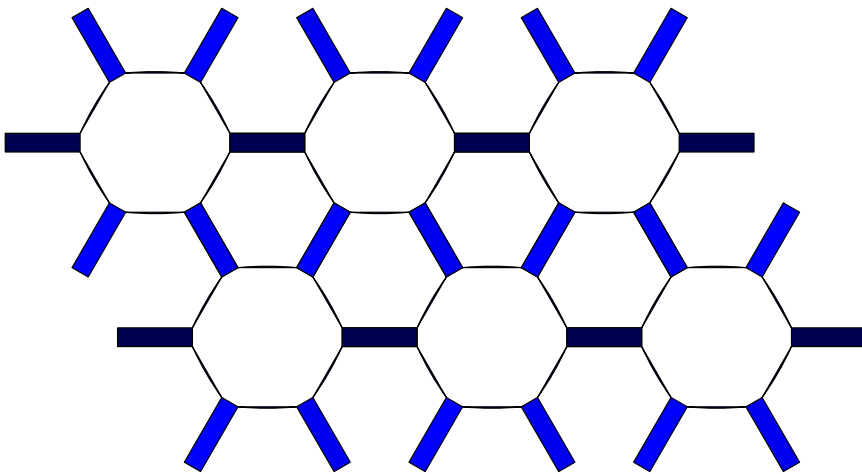
10 Couple 4 units like this



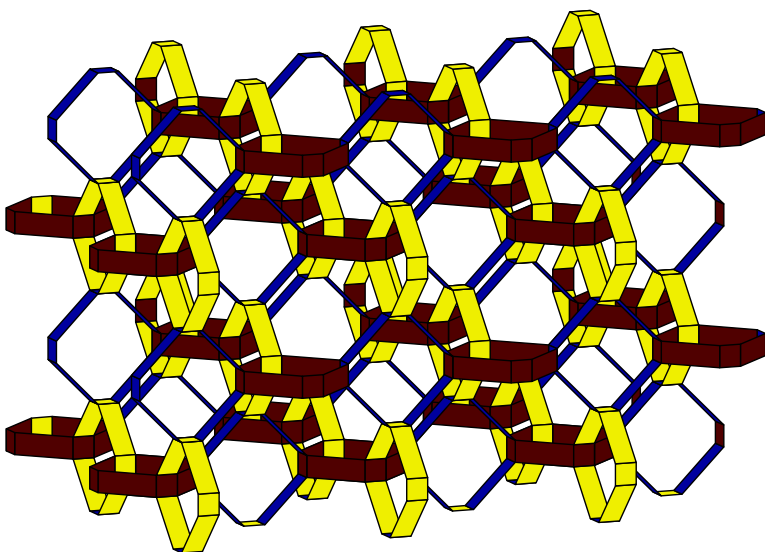
11 Bend units as shown to lock firmly



12 Couple units to this two by two to make a garland. Use stop unit at the ends.



13 This network consists of two kinds of rings:
6 unit rings and 2 unit rings.



14 Crystal of 4 unit rings in three dimensions
